
Dear Parents,

On Monday, April 24th, a senior high school student reported to cafeteria personnel that they had discovered a bug in their "Popcorn Chicken Bowl." A "Popcorn Chicken Bowl" consists of mashed potatoes, mixed with corn, and topped with popcorn chicken and gravy. After the student had shown the cafeteria staff the bug, they stopped serving the "Popcorn Chicken" entree. After investigating, it is our belief that the bug was a "corn earworm" that came in the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Federal Subsidized frozen corn commodity. We receive this product in 30 lb frozen bulk packages. This entrée was served only at the high school on Monday, and there have been no additional reports.


